Annual Security Report

Academic Affairs maintains a Crime Log, updated within two business days of the department receiving a report of a crime, to keep the institutional community informed about campus crime. This log is maintained in compliance with the Clery Act, which mandates that the institution publish information about reported crimes within the campus jurisdiction on campus and public property, as defined by the Act.

This log is maintained for 60 days and may also be inspected in the Academic Affairs office Monday–Friday 8:30 a.m.–4:00 p.m. To inspect logs older than 60 days, please allow two business days. The Institution may temporarily withhold information in some cases if there is clear and convincing evidence that the release of information would:

- Jeopardize an ongoing investigation
- Jeopardize the safety of an individual
- Cause a suspect to flee or evade detection
- Result in the destruction of evidence.

Information will be disclosed once the adverse effect is no longer likely to occur.

Annually, Academic Affairs gathers the Crime Log data along with data obtained from reports made to the Memphis Police Department to prepare the annual campus safety and security report. The Annual Security Report is disseminated to students, faculty, and interested community members, as defined by the Clery Act.
